



T Marsh Ltd - Frequently Asked Question

1. What types of Cornish granite do you supply?

We supply locally sourced Cornish granite, including building stone, quoins, lintels, steps, capping stones, kerbs and bespoke hand-finished pieces. All items are crafted at Trenoweth Quarry using traditional stonemasonry methods.

2. Do you offer bespoke or made-to-measure granite products?

Yes. Our skilled stonemasons regularly create custom granite pieces, including lintels, quoins, plinths, windowsills, thresholds, steps, gateposts and architectural details. If you have measurements or a design in mind, we can work to your specification.

3. Can I visit the quarry to view stone in person?

Yes. Customers are welcome to visit our yard at Trenoweth Quarry, Mabe Burnthouse TR3 7RN, to view available granite and discuss their project. We recommend calling ahead to ensure someone is available to assist you.

4. Finding the quarry.

We would recommend that you do not type our postcode into your satnav as it will take you to Trenoweth, which is on the opposite side of the hill from the quarry. Either use TR10 9HH which is Joe Sawmills postcode. They share a site with us. Or follow What3words; *chapters.guest.muscular*

5. Do you supply reclaimed granite?

We often have reclaimed or second-hand granite available in our reclamation area. These pieces can be adapted or re-worked to suit new projects, such as plinths, steps or garden features.

6. Do you deliver granite products?

Yes. We can arrange delivery throughout Cornwall and, depending on the product, further afield. Delivery costs vary depending on size, weight, time and location.

7. What is the lead time for bespoke granite work?

Lead times vary depending on the complexity of the job and current workload. Standard items may be available quickly, while bespoke pieces typically require additional time for cutting and hand-finishing. We'll provide an estimated timescale when you place your order. **Note:** *Stone is a natural product which can have cracks. It is not uncommon for a stonemason to be working*

on a product and the stone cracks. This results in us having to start again. Therefore, giving definite lead-times can be difficult sometimes.

8. Do you work with builders, landscapers and architects?

Yes. We regularly supply granite to local builders, landscapers, architects and contractors across Cornwall.

9. Is your granite locally sourced?

All our granite is sourced from Trenoweth Quarry in Cornwall. We are proud to supply genuine Cornish granite, hand-finished on site using traditional stonemasonry skills.

10. Can you help me choose the right stone for my project?

Absolutely. Whether you're replacing steps, building a wall, creating a garden feature or designing something bespoke, we're always happy to advise on the best granite for your needs.
